TOUR OF THE MUSEUM OF WELSH CRICKET AT SOPHIA GARDENS FOLLOWED BY LUNCH AND TALK ON BREWING AT THE BRAGDY A CHEGIN

THURSDAY 30th MARCH 2023

Opened in 2012 as the first sports-specific Museum in Wales, the CC4 Museum of Welsh Cricket at Sophia Gardens has since become the first fully-accredited cricket museum in the UK. It features a series of fascinating displays, as well as commemorative films, celebrating the long and proud heritage of cricket in Wales. Situated on the first floor of the National Cricket Centre at Sophia Gardens the Museum was created by Glamorgan Cricket in partnership with CC4, the Cardiff-based multimedia company and e-learning specialists. In particular, the displays show how cricket is the oldest team game in Wales - older even than rugby! Other displays show how cricket equipment has changed over time, with a number of items used by Glamorgan legends on display for the first-ever time.

Our visit will begin at 10.30 am and last about two hours.

For lunch we are booked into the nearby Bragdy a Chegin/Brewhouse and Kitchen at 1.00 pm. This will be a two course meal and the menu choices will be sent to those booking for this outing. Housed in the historic Sophia Gardens Lodge, the pub has its own mini-brewery and after lunch we will have a brief tour of this and enjoy a few samples of the beer it produces. So it might be a good idea to leave cars at home!

The all-inclusive cost of this outing is £25.
